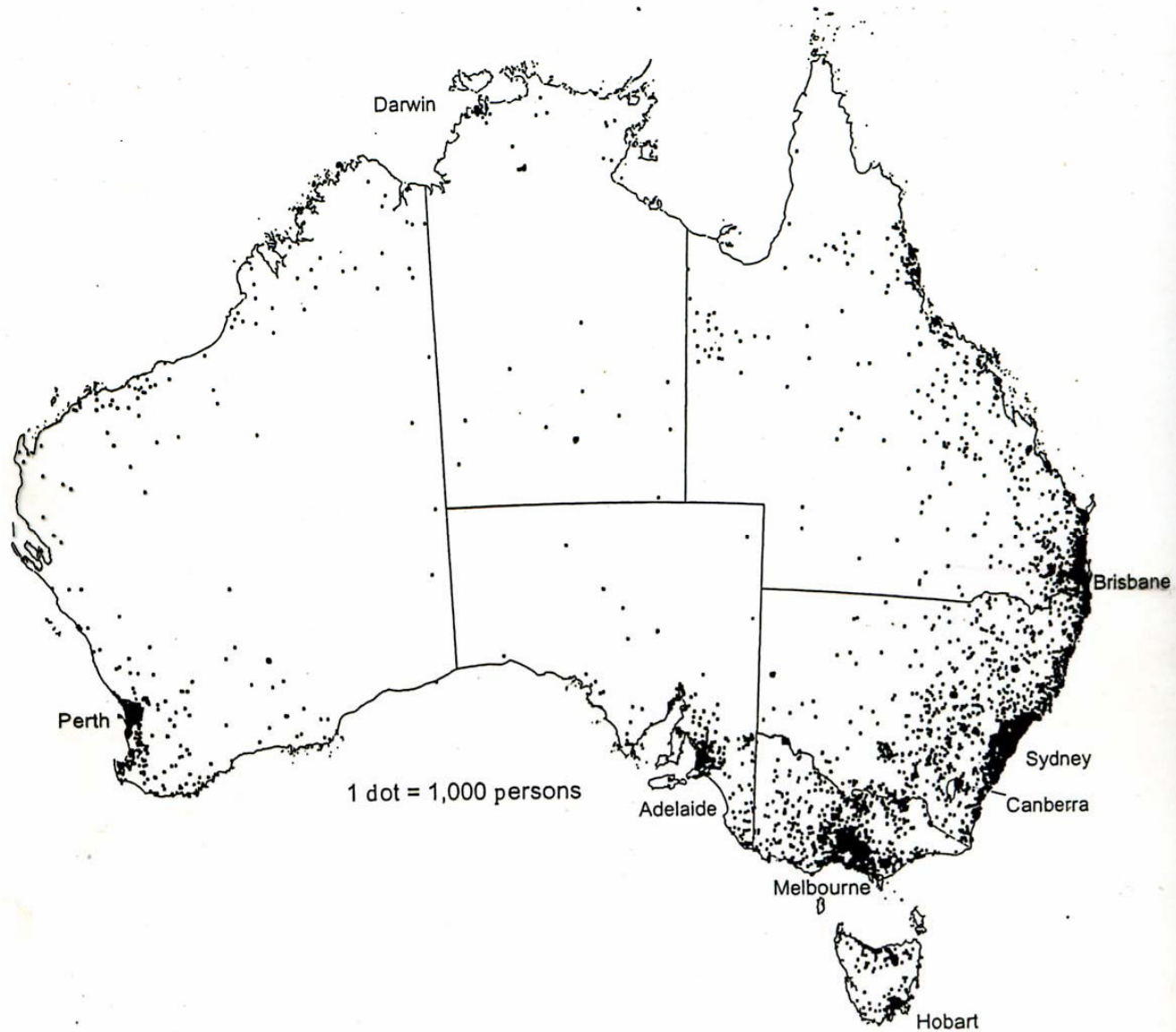

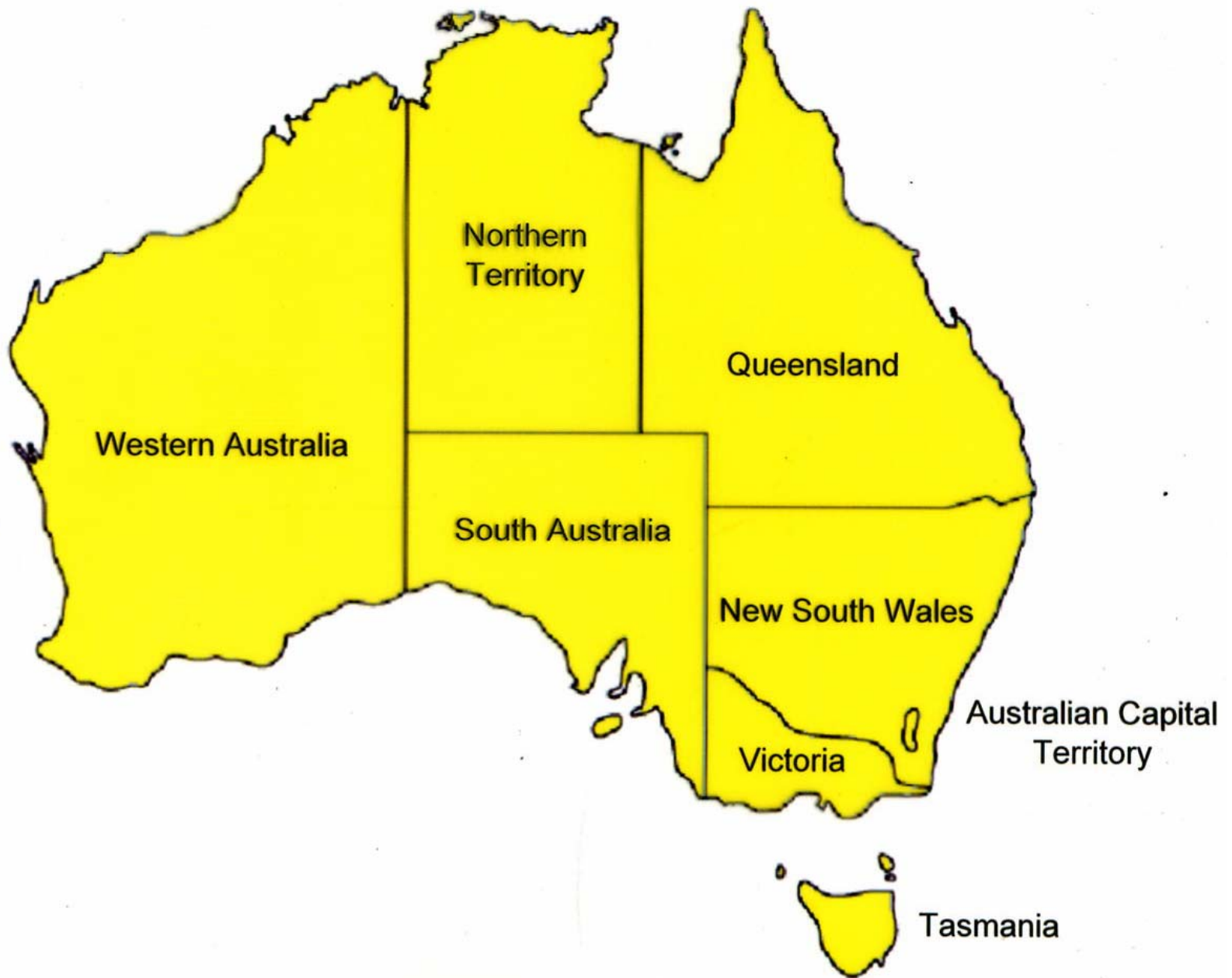

5.15 POPULATION(a) DISTRIBUTION — 30 June 2003

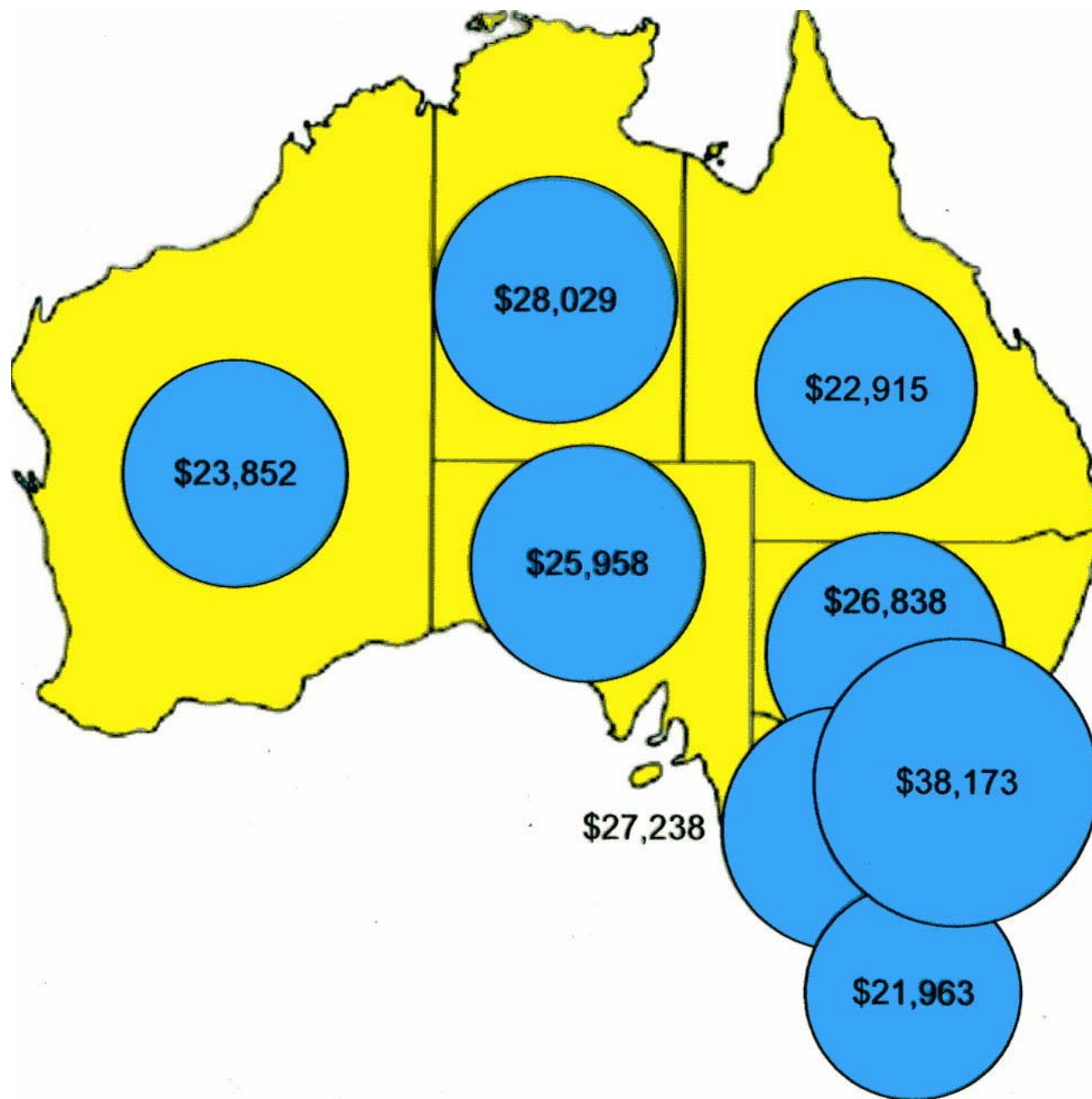

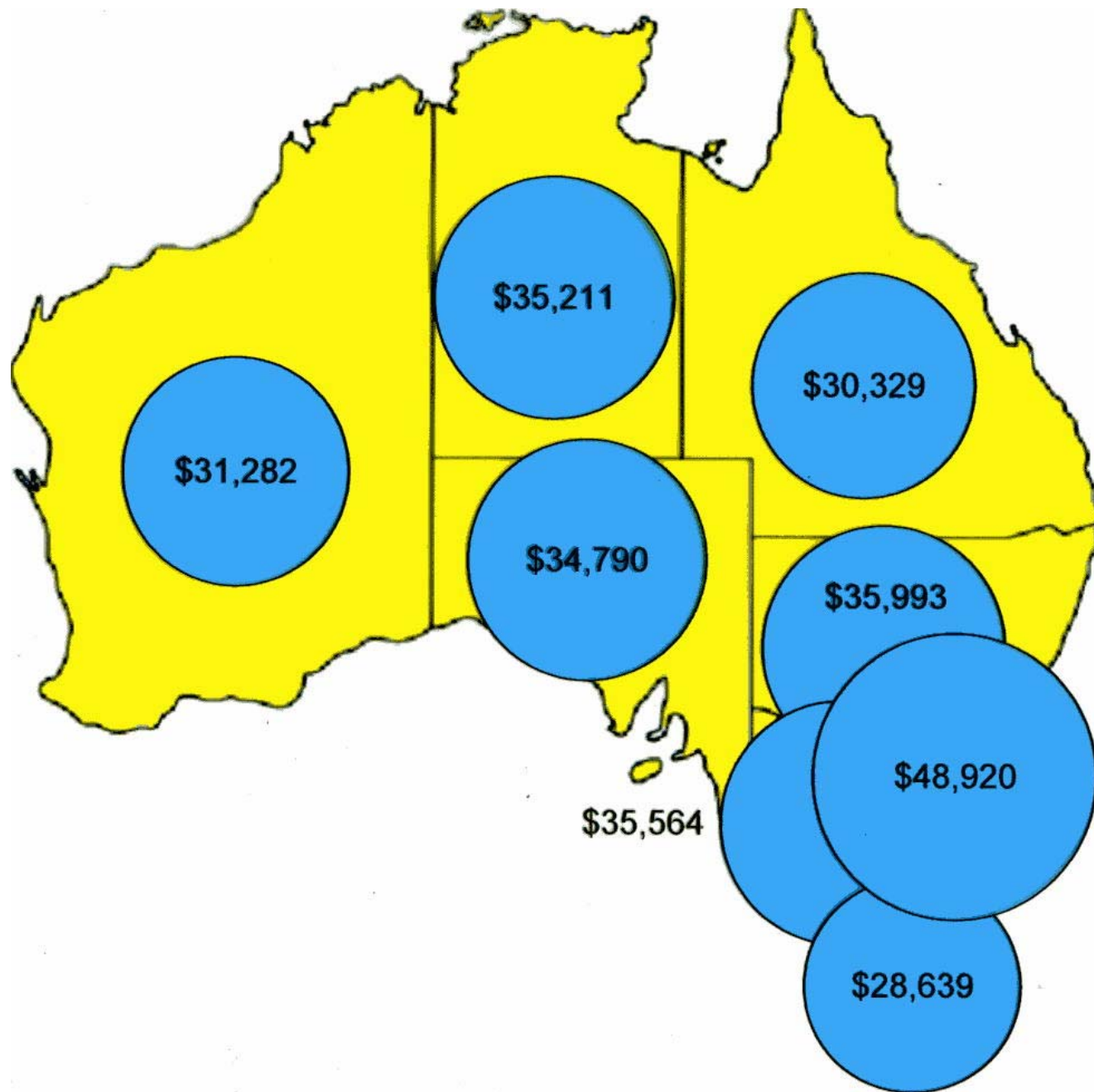

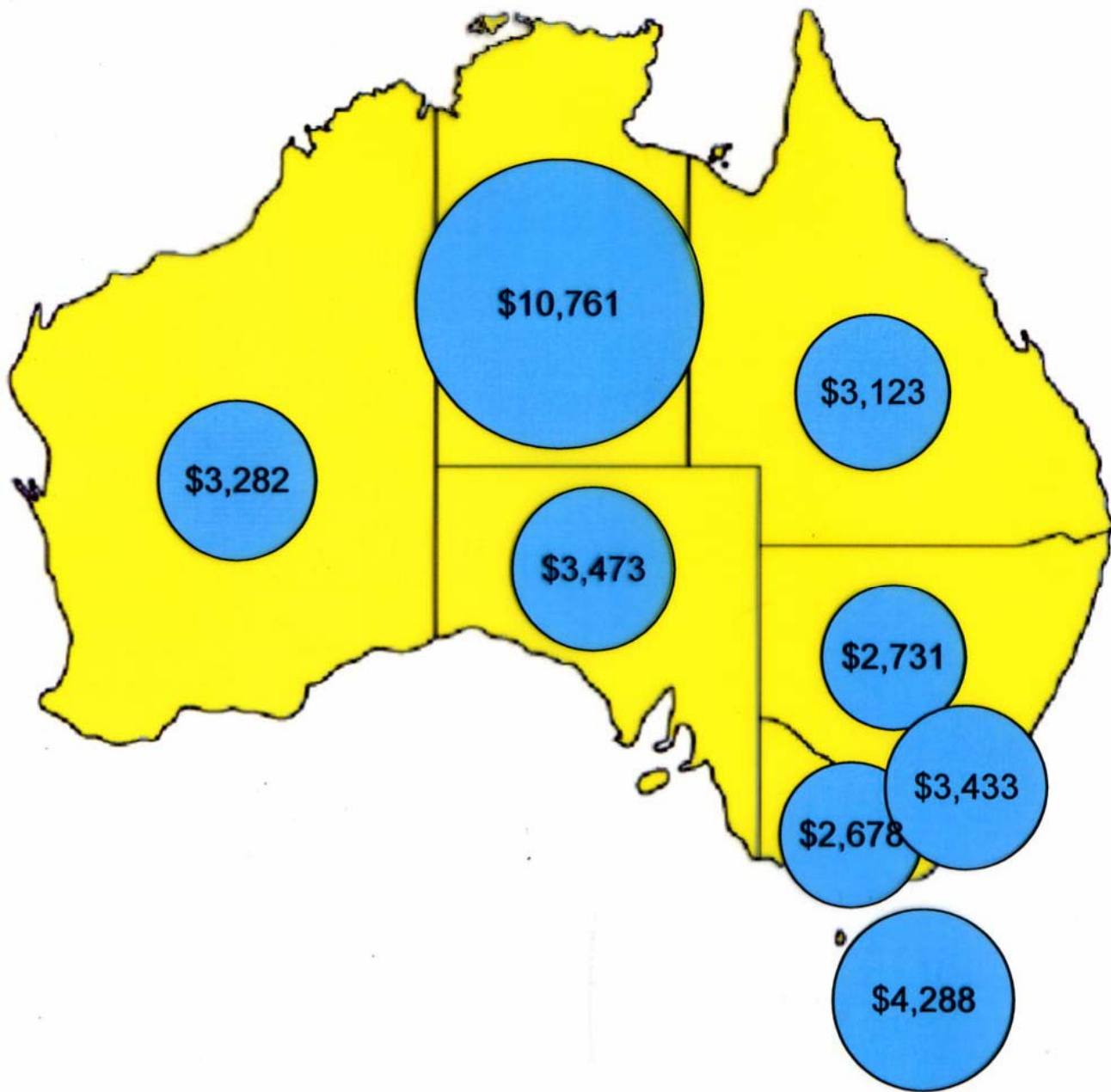

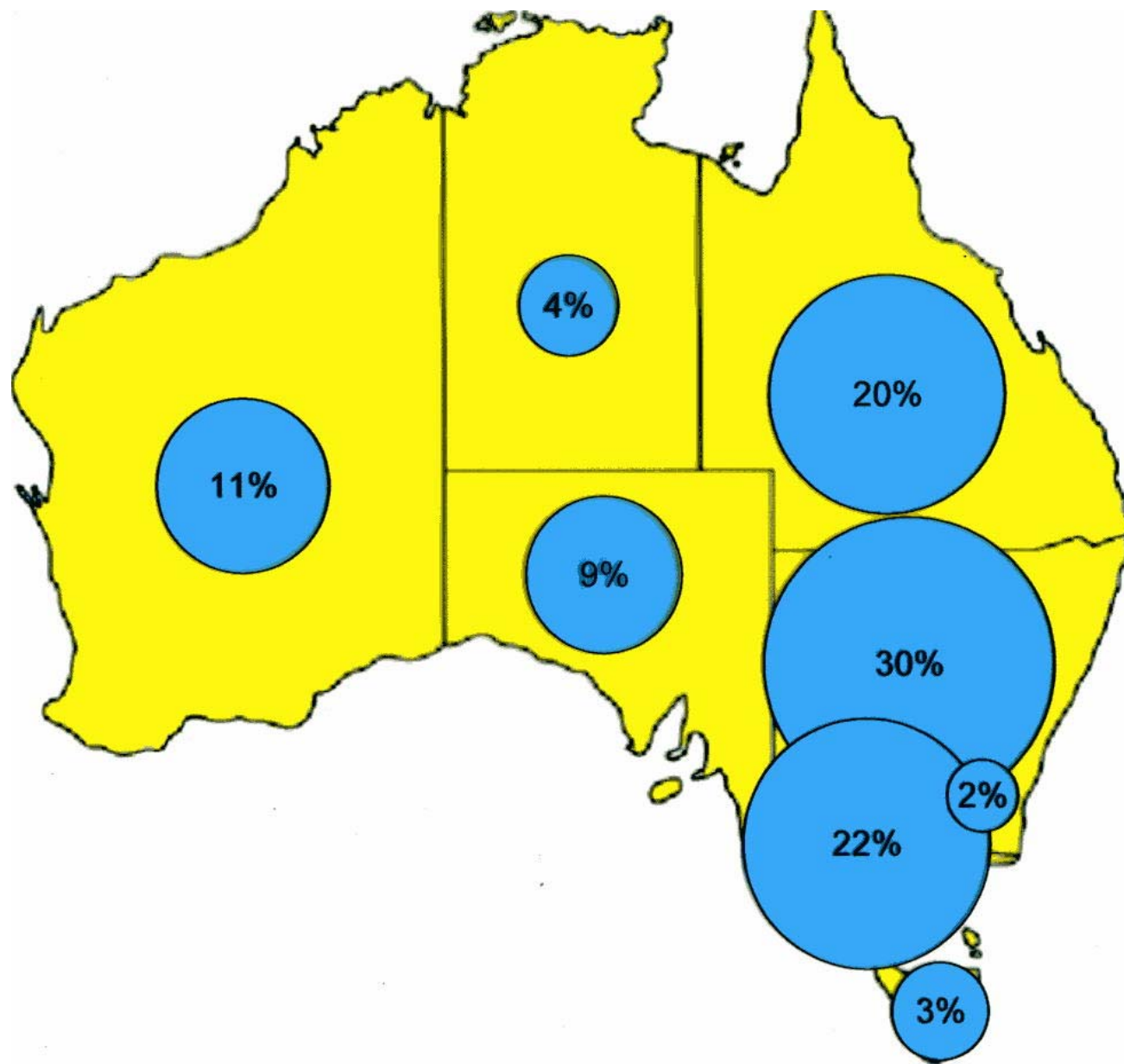
Disposable Household Income per Capita



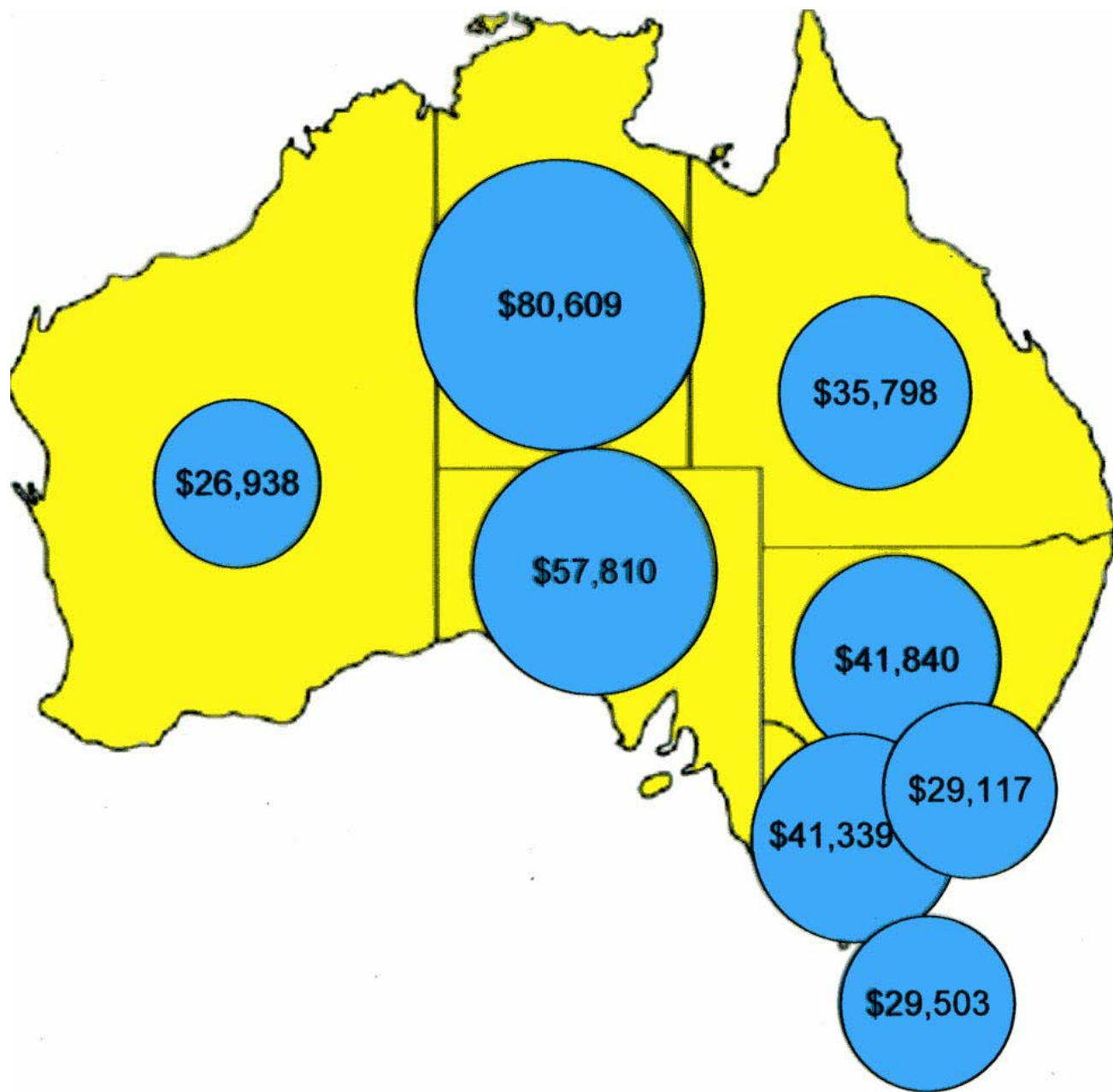
Gross Household Income per Capita



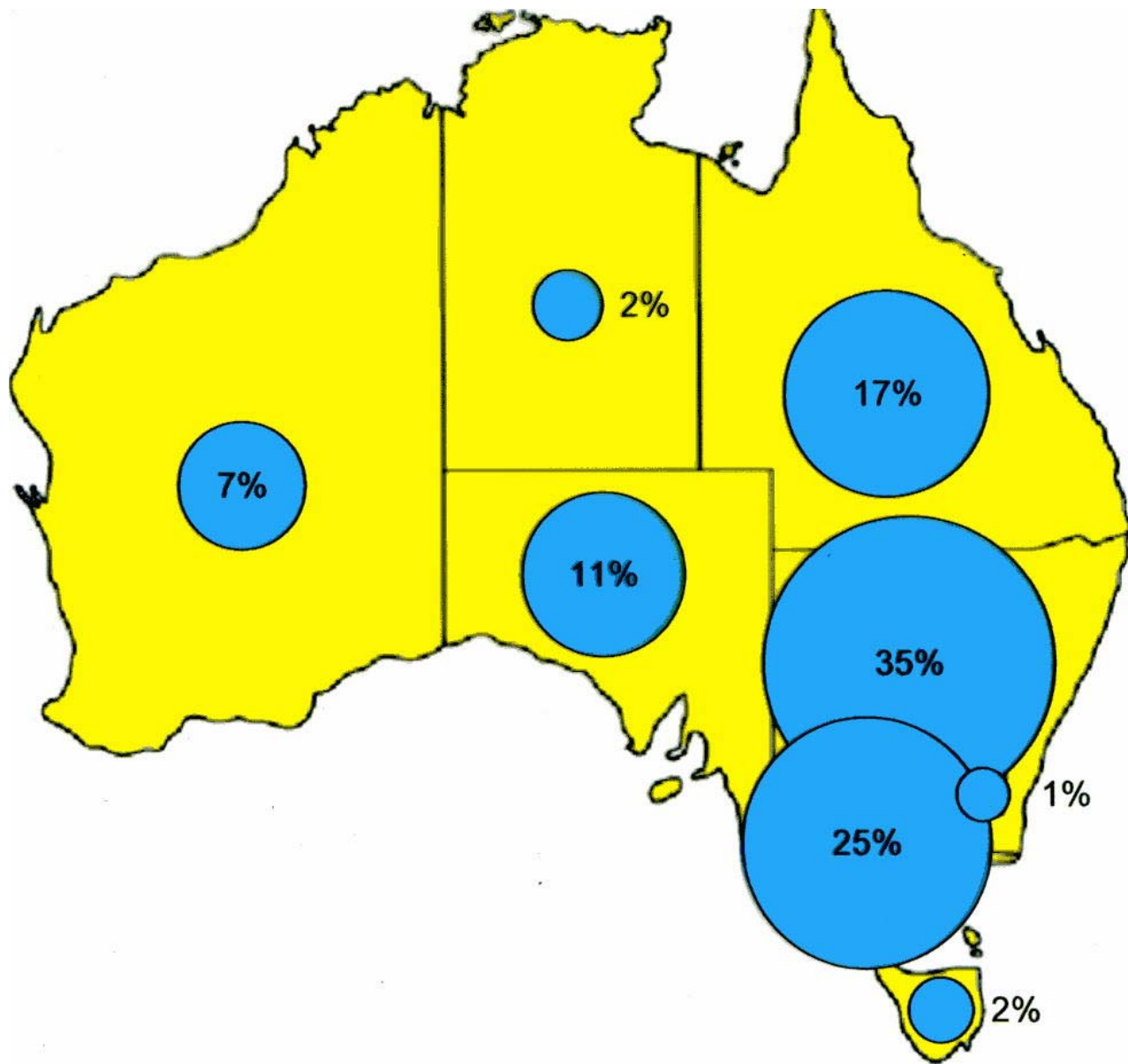
Commonwealth Payments per Capita



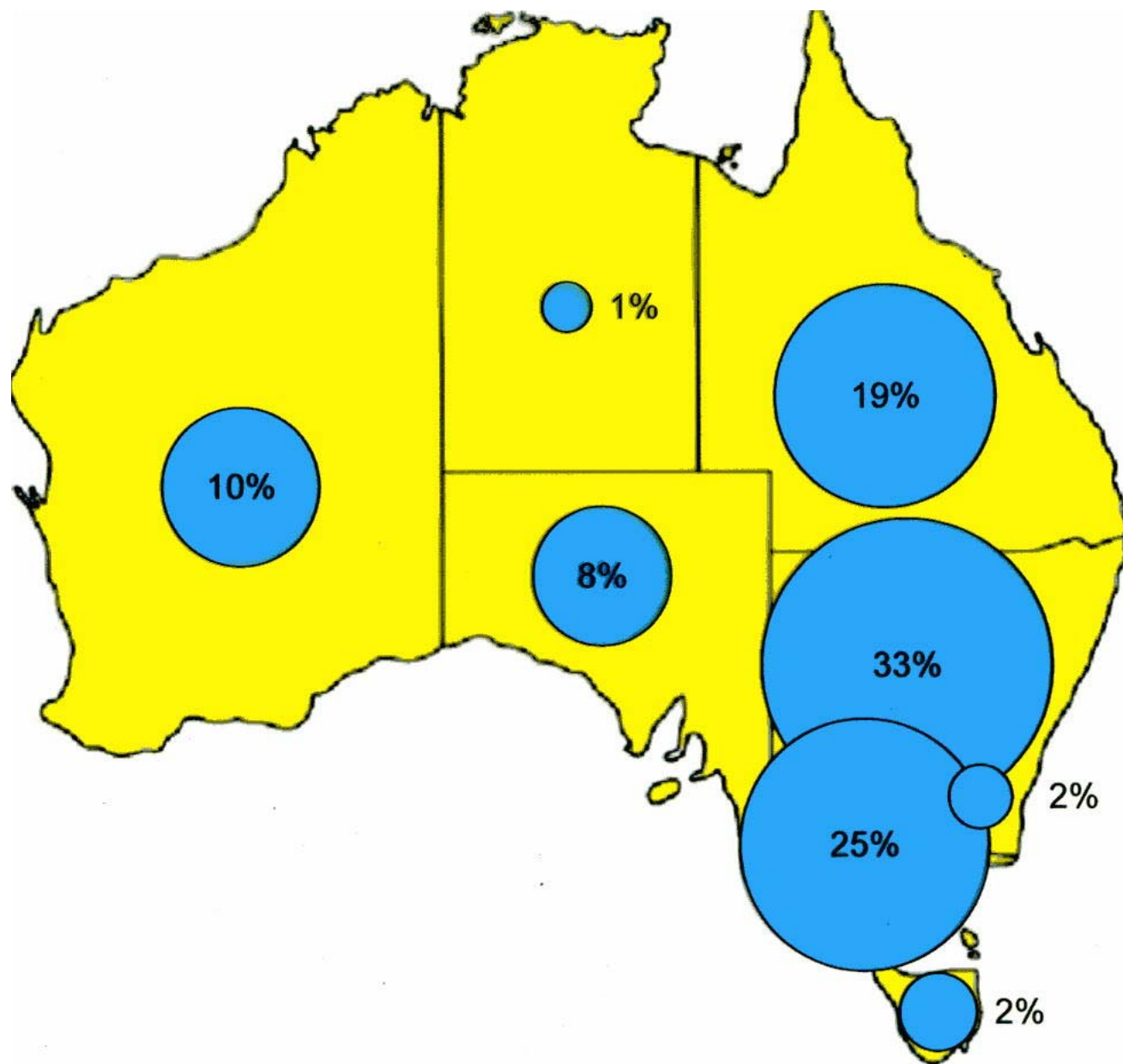
Proportion of Commonwealth Payments
