  - \* 24 Intermediate Governments (23 Provinces and 1 Autonomous Federal District).





- 3 COMPENSATIONS FOR THE USE OF EXTRAORDINARY TAXES ON FOREIGN TRADE.
- 4 COMPENSATIONS FOR COMPSUMPTION OF NON TRADITIONAL NATURAL RESOURCES.
- DECISION ABOUT "CONSTITUTIONAL MANDATED" FEDERAL GRANTS IN AID TO PROVINCES.
