Multi-Level Governance



- Common pattern of multi-level governance
 - Determination of the policy framework
 - Delivery of Health services
- Problem of managing intergovernmental relations

Models of Intergovernmental Relations



Classical Federalism

- traditional model
- "overlap and duplication"

Shared-Cost Federalism

- conditional grants (Australia)
- block grants (Canada)
- unilateralism

Joint Decision-Making Federalism

- strong coordination (Germany)
- danger of paralysis

- Growing Pattern of Asymmetry
 - Belgium
 - Spain
 - United Kingdom
- Resistance to Formal Asymmetry
 - Canada

Formal Intergovernmental Bodies

- strong mechanisms (Germany, Australia)
- weak mechanisms (Canada, United States)

Political Processes

- political parties (Germany, Belgium)
- intergovernmental political conflict
